

Please drive slowly thru the communities. The streets are not a thoroughfare. It is private property and speed limit signs are posted everywhere- PLEASE OBSERVE THE 15 MPH LIMIT FOR SAFETY OF ALL. Also please do NOT cut thru the community clubhouse lots to cut off a few seconds. There are always people milling about so if not going to the community clubhouse specifically, please avoid the lots.

Inoperative vehicles: No junk, inoperative, or unlicensed vehicles may be used or parked in the community at any time. Owners will be given a notice for removal prior to it being towed.

There are vehicles being stored at the CLVI storage lot with expired registrations that need to be brought

up-to-date. Please take care of this problem as soon possible.

If you are doing any alteration of your home-painting, planting trees, altering the outside of the home or lot in any way, please complete the resident alteration form (available in the office) & submit for review and approval by the office. Upon approval a permit (either painting or alteration as applicable) will be issued for you to pick up at the office and display in the front window while work is being completed.

Armadillos are a problem that is often reported at CLV. They are looking for insects or worms and the best way to rid them from your yard is to repel them with scents that they hate. You can go with Mole Max, a commercial product that is at Home Depot. It worked for me, but is expensive at around \$25. Epson salts, cayenne pepper, pine, castor oil and vinegar are also effective. These strong smells will overwhelm their noses, repelling them from the area. Google it for the recipes, as trapping them isn't an option.
