Home of the Month Winners!

Congratulations go out to the June Home of the Month Winners!

CLV1-#515 Dave & Sandy Vossberg & CLV2-#2031 Steve & Lorraine Baker. Thank you for all your hard work to make your homes the pick of the month. Good luck to all trying to be chosen in the coming months.

Gate Update- We have not been given a date when they will be operational but hopefully, soon. As of now, they will be open during the day just like the old gates were. There will be the ability to enter a 4-digit code at the 2 main entry points if you do not have your clicker. **The 4 digit is your lot number. If you have a 3-digit lot number then add a zero in front. EXAMPLE- Lot 200 = 0200. This information should NOT be given out to anyone who is NOT a resident. Visitors will be able to find the person they are looking for in the call box directory that will be located at the main entrance to each park and call them on that call box. When the resident picks up, they will be able to remotely open the gates from their phone. That continues to be all we know as of this writing. Any update will be circulated via email & on Facebook. We still have clickers in stock for those that have not gotten one. \$20 check or money order made payable to Country Lakes for the deposit of each clicker.**

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Speed limit: Please drive slowly through the communities - Our streets in the parks are not a thoroughfare. It is private property and speed limit signs are posted everywhere- **PLEASE OBSERVE THE 15 MPH LIMIT FOR SAFETY OF ALL.** Also please DO NOT cut through the community clubhouse lots to cut off a few seconds. There are always people milling about so if not going to the community clubhouse specifically, please avoid the lots.

Inoperative vehicles: Per current rules effective 3/1/2022 “No junk, inoperative, or unlicensed vehicles may be used or parked in the community at any time”. Owners will be given a 24-hour notice for removal before it is towed at their expense.

Pet Owners- Make sure to obey all rules regarding pets, including not walking your pet on any other homeowner lots or in the amenity areas- Dog parks are provided for your pets' use or use your lot but pick up immediately after your pet.

Yards and homes: Please make arrangements to have your home cleaned and beds weeded as summer means mold and weeds. Failure to do so will result in a 14-day notice to cure, followed by staff doing the work and your account being charged if not done timely. I'd rather the residents do the work than have to charge to have it done.

Business: No business or commercial enterprise shall be permitted to be operated by any resident, or any guest, or invitee of any resident from or within the community. No Pop-Up Restaurants!

Refuse: Garbage or yard waste may not be placed on the street any earlier than 4 PM the night before scheduled pick up. Violations of this rule have resulted in Country Lakes staff removing the items and charging the resident. The intent is to minimize the time we have to look at trash or refuse.

Cleanliness: Your lot and home must be free of debris. Refuse containers including 1 recycle and 1 refuse, bicycles and grills must be left on the carport (any other location for placement or storage requires advance written permission of Community Management); all other items, containers, or equipment will be placed out of sight. All items not approved to be stored outside the home, carport or porch must be stored in the home's shed or in the home. It is hurricane season, so anything that could become a projectile needs to be stored or secured for the safety of all.

- Remember to make a note of this: in case of emergency, the Sheriff's phone number for this area is 941-747-3011 ext 2260.

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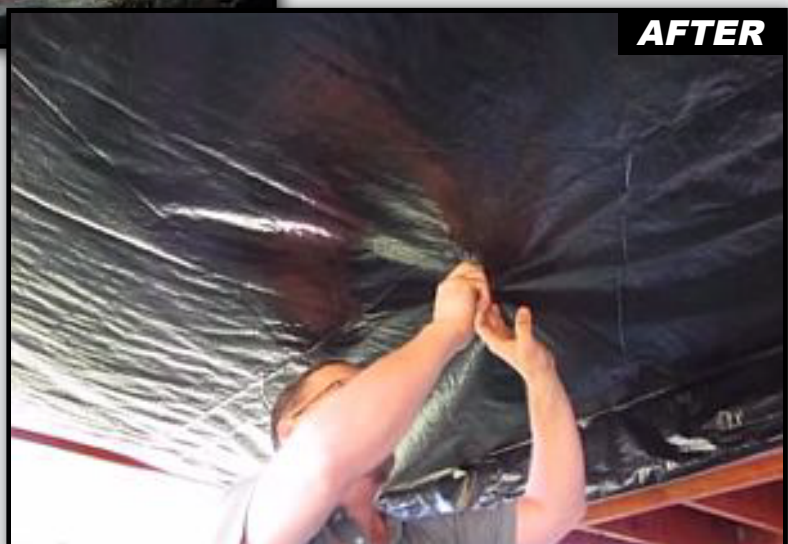
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NOTES FROM THE ADVISORY BOARD

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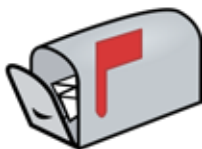

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GUIDELINES FOR CLVII RAC RESIDENT EVENTS

1. The event head count will not exceed 120 people for any event. The posted number of persons listed by the fire department shows 164 however, that number includes the library, game room, and fitness center. Those areas are not usually used during events.
2. All events are posted in the Village Voice, posters at the clubhouse, and on Facebook 3 weeks before the event. Tickets go on sale 3 weeks before the event. Check the posters and/or Facebook to determine who is selling tickets.
3. Events that are categorized as only entertainment will cost \$10 per ticket (refundable at the door). Since there is no food at these events tickets can be purchased up until the day of the event if tickets are still available. **You must cancel within 48 hours of the event to receive a refund. Tickets must be returned to whoever is selling tickets for that event so they can be distributed to those on the waiting list, if any. You cannot sell or give your ticket(s) to anyone else. If you do not return your ticket within 48 hours of the event your money will not be refunded.**
4. Events that are categorized as including food will cost \$20 per ticket (refundable at the door). The sale of these tickets **will be cut off 7 days before the event** to ensure we get a correct headcount to the caterer. **You must cancel within 48 hours of the event to receive a refund. Tickets must be returned to whoever is selling tickets for that event so they can be distributed to those on the waiting list, if any. You cannot sell or give your ticket(s) to anyone else. If you do not return your ticket within 48 hours of the event your money will not be refunded.**
5. Guest or family tickets are not refundable. They will also be placed on the waiting list and can only purchase tickets once all residents can purchase tickets. Usually, 10 days before the event if all tickets are not sold the waiting list people will get the opportunity to purchase tickets in the order they are on the waiting list.

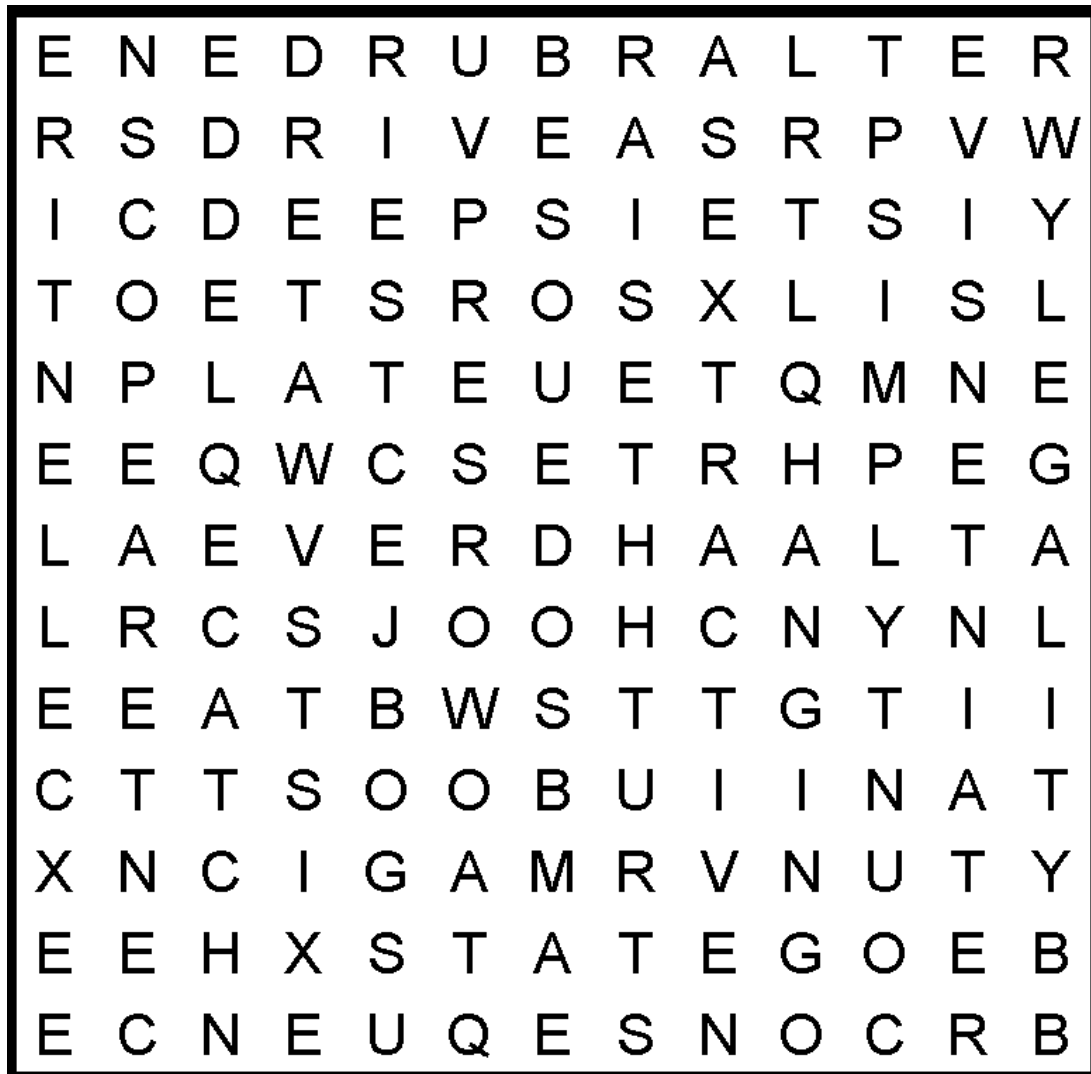
